The Royal Air Force Benevolent Fund

Using Gift Aid means that for every pound you give, the Royal Air Force Benevolent Fund can claim an extra 25 pence* from the Inland Revenue, helping your donation to go further.

This means that £10 can be turned into £12.50 just as long as your donation is covered by a Gift Aid Declaration. Imagine what a difference that could make and it doesn't cost you a thing.

Notes: You can cancel this Declaration at any time by notifying the RAF Benevolent Fund. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains tax equal to the tax that the Fund reclaim, you can cancel your Declaration.

If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return (currently 25p for each pound you give).

Please notify the RAF Benevolent Fund, in writing, if you change your name or address.

*By completing this Gift Aid Declaration the RAF Benevolent Fund will continue to receive an additional 28p. The RAF Benevolent Fund can claim Gift Aid tax relief of 25p on every pound you give. HMRC will also be operating transitional provisions for Gift Aid donations made from 6/4/2008 until 5/4/2011, paying a Government supplement of 3p on every pound you give.
