

## Gift Aid Declaration

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**Using Gift Aid means that for every £1 you give, the Royal Air Force Benevolent Fund can claim an extra 25 pence from HM Revenue & Customs. Imagine what a difference that could make and it doesn't cost you a thing.**

Simply complete this form and return it to the Fundraising Team at the address below.

Please treat all gifts of money that I have made in the past four years and all future gifts of money that I make from the date of this Declaration as Gift Aid donations, until I notify you otherwise.

To qualify for Gift Aid you must pay an amount of UK Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax for each tax year (6th April one year to 5th April the next year) that is at least equal to the amount of tax that the RAF Benevolent Fund will reclaim on your gifts for that tax year.

Tax claimed by the RAF Benevolent Fund

- We will reclaim 25p of tax on every £1 you give on or after 6th April 2008 .

If you pay income tax at the higher rate, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self Assessment tax return if you want to receive the additional tax relief due to you (currently 25p for each £1 you give). You are able to nominate a charity to receive all or part of this repayment. The Royal Air Force Benevolent Fund is a participating charity in this scheme and our identification code which you are required to enter on your tax return, should you wish us to receive your repayment, is: - UAE59LG
